Borough Treasure Scheme - Gives leisure opportunities for people living in Doncaster who are over 60 years old. Those who join receive vouchers for local leisure activities such as a free game of bowling at Doncaster Superbowl, discounted rates to Doncaster Little Theatre and the Greyhound Stadium, activity days at the Dome have included swimming, salsa dancing, badminton and get a healthy two course lunch for £2. Free travel for carers - If the person you care for qualifies for a Mobility Pass and in receipt of High Rate Care Component of Disability Living Allowance they can get a special Mobility Pass that allows a carer to travel with them FREE of charge. Travel discounts for people unemployed or on a low income living in South Yorkshire

Off-Peak Travel Master Pass, which costs £13.50, gives unlimited travel by bus, tram or train Monday-Friday from 9am until the end of normal service and all day Saturday, Sunday and Bank Holidays until the end of normal service. To buy a Pass go to the Travel South Yorkshire Information Centre, Duke Street and take with you a passport size photograph, proof of address and proof of the benefit you are receiving. Tax Credit rebate !!!!

If you had a child that was born between 6th April 1986 and 5th April 2003 you may be entitled to a £520-£1,040 allowance. To be entitled the child must have lived with you for all or part of 2002/2003, you will also have needed to have worked and paid tax for all or part of 2002 / 2003.

From the St Leger (racecourse) roundabout exit onto Bawtry Road (A638). Stay on Bawtry Road (A638) until you pass the Punches Hotel at these traffic lights turn left into Church Lane. When you come to the staggered junction, continue ahead on Church Lane, we are on the right.
